Each entry form is for 2 students who must be members of the Middle Temple and will appear as a team. Your email address will need to be passed on to your opponents during the course of this competition (exchange of skeletons).

The heats will begin in January 2010 once term has started, and take place at 5.30pm and usually on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays - you will be advised of the venue (they are all within Middle Temple), when you are given the problem. The semi-finals take place in Hall after dinner in June 2010 and the final in Hall in October 2010.

The closing date to apply is 4.00pm on **Friday 13th November 2009**. Application forms which are returned unsigned will be void. There will be an introductory talk on Mooting in early December 2009. Mooting workshops to be arranged by the MTSA (look out for on a notice on the boards). Details of this will be available in due course.

If we fail to exchange authorities as specified in the rules or fail to attend for our allotted matches, the other team will be deemed to have won.
4. We understand that our email addresses will be given to our opponents to facilitate the exchange of authorities.
5. We understand that any changes to the team can only be made before the first round. If the Leader/Junior change places once the competition is underway, the Students' Officer should be informed before the heat and the exchange of authorities of this change.
