### **FUNDING FOR MIDDLE TEMPLE STUDENTS' ASSOCIATIONS AT UNIVERSITIES AND BVC's**

---

#### **POLICY**

1. The Committee's view is that as a part of the Inn's ongoing recruitment practices, and with the objectives of providing information to students about careers at the Bar and about the activities of the Inn, the Inn should continue to promote students associations at centres of education and activities calculated to further such objectives and the fostering and maintenance of links between such centres of education and the Inn, such funding to be distributed on a discretionary basis in response to requests, and that the availability of such funding should be advertised on the Inn's web-site and any other literature performing a similar function.

#### **AUDIT**

2. Without being unduly bureaucratic the Inn should require some proof that the event is genuine and within the purposes of the Policy, and of the proper disbursement of funding.
3. In respect of each event, therefore, the Committee will require in writing:-
  - (1) pre-event, details and a budget of the proposed event - at least in outline;
  - (2) post-event, a brief account (with copies of receipts if available) of the expenditure of funds which have been made available, and a brief report.
