

BAR REPRESENTATIVES OF THE MIDDLE TEMPLE

1. A Bar representative (Bar Rep) is a member of the Inn who has an interest in Inn activities and has volunteered or been selected to be a representative in relation to the Inn. There will generally be one Bar Rep per Chambers, except for those preferring to share the role.
2. The Inn hopes to be able to engage with members and involve them in the life of the Inn. In doing so the Inn hopes to be able to gain assistance from Bar Reps to engage with members.
3. The role of the Bar Rep is to promote the interests of the Inn by acting as a conduit between the Inn and the members of the Inn whom they represent. The Bar Rep is asked to keep themselves fully updated on relevant Inn events, to receive information and requests for participation in Inn activities from the Inn and to promote those activities to fellow Middle Templars. It is also their role to provide feedback, suggestions and requests of their own or from members to the Inn as and when the need arises.
4. The Bar Rep's main point of contact will be Membership Manager, as well as other members of the Membership Department. The Bar Rep agrees that the Inn may contact them by email.
5. Whilst there is no formal requirement to attend Inn events, it is hoped that the Bar Rep will attend and encourage other Middle Templars to attend as many Inn social or educational events as possible.
6. We realise the commitment involved and if you are unable to give that commitment in full because of practice or other reasons please let us know and we can split the job between two Middle Templars, or find someone who does have the flexibility.
7. There is no length of tenure for a Bar Rep. If you no longer wish to be the Bar Rep for any reason, it would be extremely helpful if you would identify someone else willing to take on the mantle and let the Inn know.
