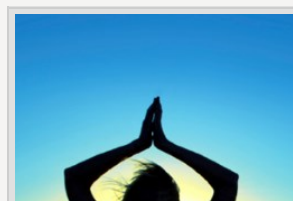


Events in July

The sessions run on Thursdays, 18:00 to 19:00, and we suggest a £5 donation to cover costs.

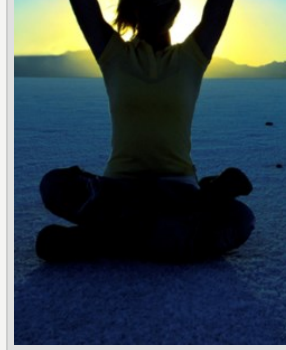

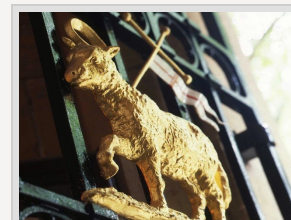


Private Guest Night - Wednesday 27 July 2016

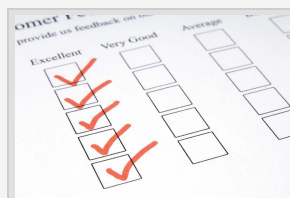
