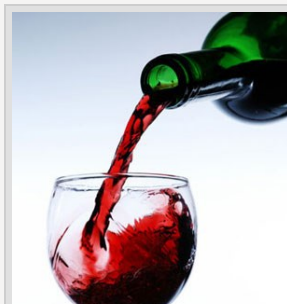
Tasting at the Temple: Middle Temple Wine Masterclass Series - Wednesday 5 October 2016

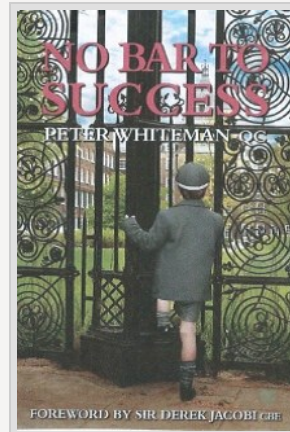

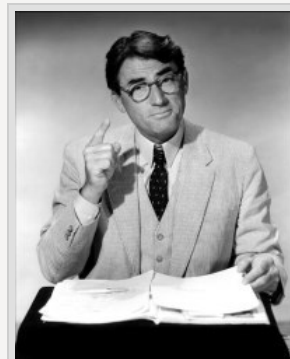

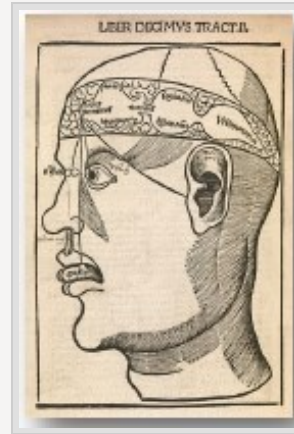
Sessions cover the essentials of practical legal research, highlight Middle Temple Library's re-sources, and compare print with electronic sources.

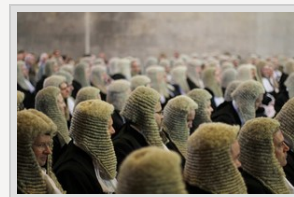

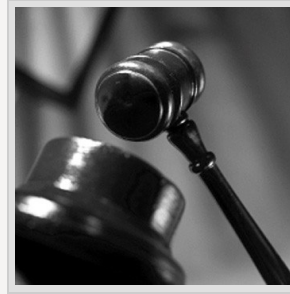


Rosamund Smith Moot Final - Monday 24 October 2016

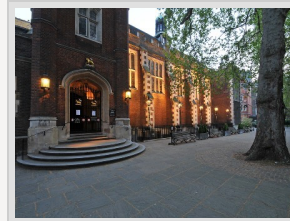

The Middle Temple Executive Committee will pick the successful candidate from a shortlist of names.

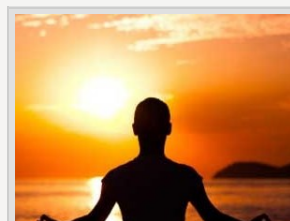

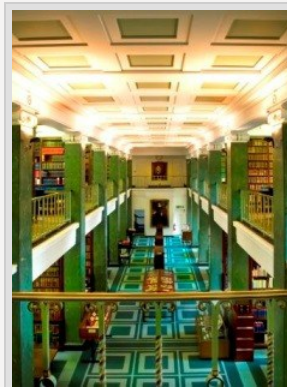

Middle Temple Lodgings

The Inn has six overnight lodgings available for hire in 3 Middle Temple Lane, a Grade II* Listed Building dating back to 1680.

Previously, the majority of members have booked this through our Treasury Department on 020 7427 4800. However, this is restricted to between the hours of 09:30 and 16:30, Monday to Friday. Whilst this method can still be used, we have also developed the online tool allowing members to book their lodgings quickly and in a simple way.



As the website can be accessed at any time throughout the day, bookings can be completed at the convenience of members. 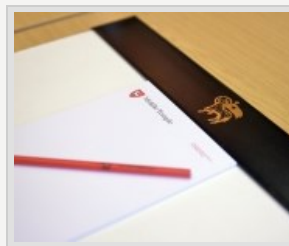

Middle Temple Library Document Delivery Service (and free coffee!)

Middle Temple members who are under ten years call AND on circuit can make use of the Library's document delivery service free-of-charge.

This is a six month trial and members will have to provide their year of call and Middle Temple membership number when making the request. Normal copyright rules apply- e.g. not more than 10% of the whole (up to a maximum of 4,000 words) of a textbook; one journal article; one case report.



Members must agree to the online declaration stating that the copy is for the purpose of specific judicial proceedings existing at the time that the copies are made, or research for a non-commercial purpose or private study and that the copy is only for these purposes and will not be supplied to any other person.

To use this service, please use the online form available at: <http://www.middletemple.org.uk/distance-service-copyright-declaration>. Eligible members must use the special trial code MTCircuits when making the request. The trial code box is found at the end of the form.

In addition, the Library is providing free tea and coffee until October, while supplies last.
