Foreword by Master Treasurer

Singapore is one of the most successful and fascinating countries in the world. Officially the Republic of Singapore, it is often referred to as the Lion City, the Garden City, or the Red Dot. It is both a global city and a sovereign state - the world's only island city-state.

In 1819, Sir Stamford Raffles founded colonial Singapore as a trading post of the East India Company; after the establishment of the British Raj, the islands were ceded to Britain and became part of its Straits Settlements in 1826. During World War II, Singapore was occupied by Japan. It gained independence from Britain in 1963, by federating with other former British territories to form Malaysia, but was expelled two years later over ideological differences. After early years of turbulence, and despite lacking natural resources and a hinterland, the nation developed rapidly as an Asian Tiger economy, based on external trade and its human capital.

The legal system of Singapore is based on the English common law system. Major areas of law – particularly administrative law, contract law, equity and trust law, property law and tort law – are largely judge-made, though certain aspects have now been modified to some extent by statutes. However, other areas of law, such as criminal law, company law and family law, are almost completely statutory in nature.

Our main aims in 2016 will be threefold. First, to strengthen our links with our own 600+ plus alumni in Singapore, who will be looking forward to renewing and forming new acquaintances with their Inn of Court. Second, to enjoy, in the company of many of the finest lawyers and judges in Singapore an interesting and exciting programme of discussions and meetings. And last but not least, to show our support for the rule of law, and for the profession of advocacy, in a part of the world to which we owe much, and which still acknowledges strongly its ties with us.

I thank everyone who will be coming with us, and all those who have played, and will play, a part in the arrangements, especially our Singaporean Benchers, Justice Chao Hick Tin and The Rt. Hon V K Rajah.

I know that for Caroline and myself this will be a highlight of the year, and it will, I hope, also represent a memorable step in the development of the international influence of the Middle Temple.

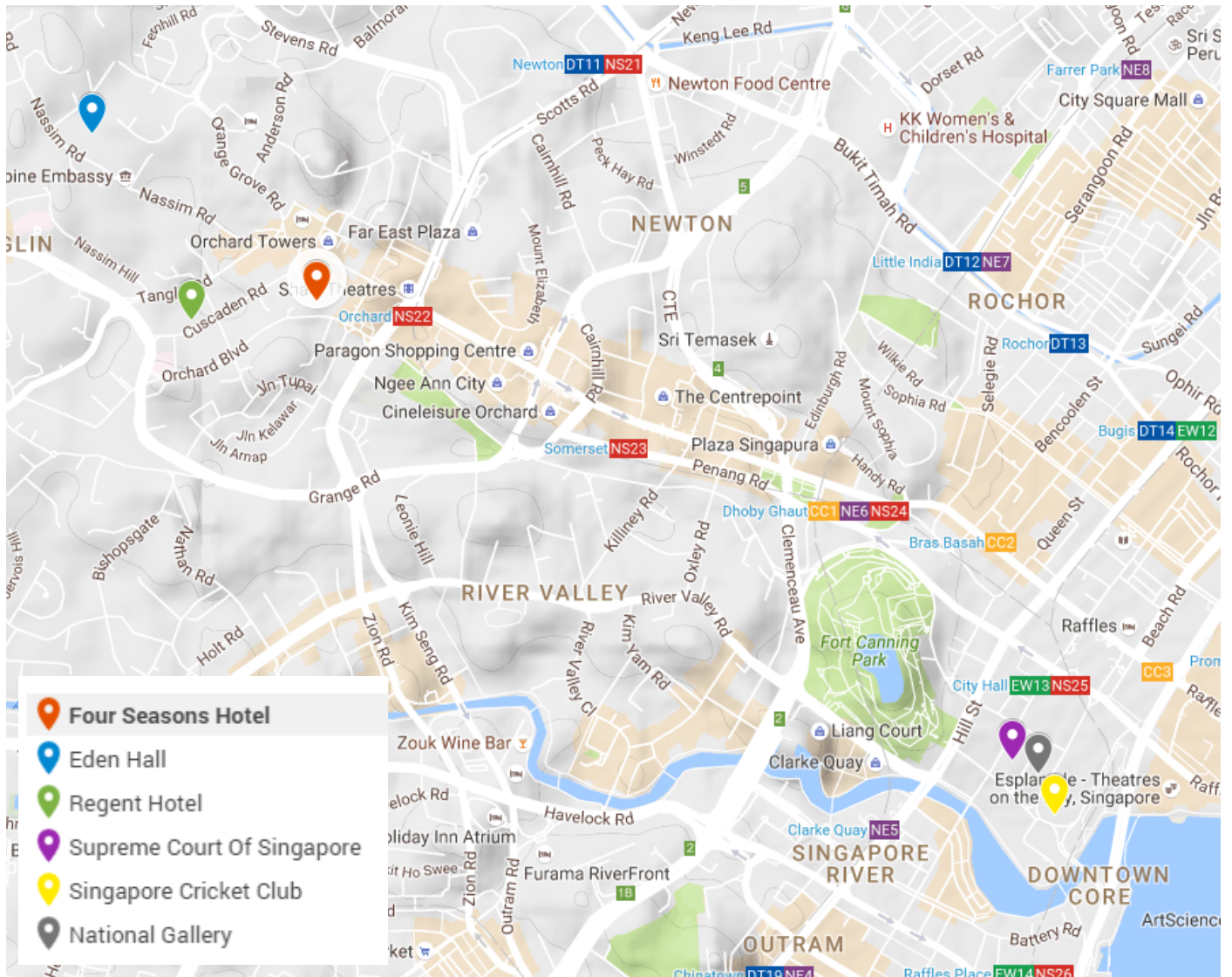

VISA Requirements

Visitors to Singapore can either enter the country without a visa or in some cases they must first obtain a visa. Citizens of almost 80% of the world may travel to Singapore for a period ranging from 30 days to 90 days. Only 35 countries require visa for Singapore. They are categorised into countries eligible to apply for an electronic visa and countries whose citizens need a full visa from a Singaporean embassy or consulate.

All visitors to Singapore must:

1. hold a passport or travel document valid for 6 months at the time of departure,
2. hold an onward or return ticket,
3. have sufficient funds to stay in Singapore.
4. Entry facilities to the next destination
5. Visa for entry into Singapore (if applicable)
6. convince an immigration officer that they have ties (job, home, financial assets or family) that will take them back to their home country

The Zika Virus

On 29 August 2016, The Ministry of Health (MOH) confirmed localised community spread of Zika Virus Infection in Singapore. Given that the Zika virus is spread by the Aedes mosquito vector, MOH cannot rule out further community transmission in Singapore, since some of those tested positive also live or work in other parts of Singapore. As such, vector control remains the mainstay in reducing the spread of Zika.

Most people infected with the Zika virus do not develop symptoms. Otherwise, they usually develop within 3 to 12 days after the mosquito bite and are similar to those of dengue and chikungunya. Symptoms include:

- Fever
- Rashes
- Joint pains, muscle pain, headache
- Conjunctivitis (red eyes)
- Symptoms often last between 4 to 7 days.

Scandalising the Judiciary

In Singapore, the offence of scandalising the judiciary is committed when a person performs any act or publishes any writing that is calculated to bring a court or a judge of the court into contempt, or to lower his/her authority. An act or statement that alleges bias, lack of impartiality, impropriety or any wrongdoing concerning a judge in the exercise of his judicial function falls within the offence.

The British High Commission in Singapore have recently issued a statement urging Singapore and all countries that retain “scandalising the judiciary” to abolish it. This was brought to our attention by Ms Foo Chi Hsia, High Commissioner of the Republic of Singapore.

Middle Temple is not taking a position on the recent comments and we kindly ask that all members refrain from discussing it during the Amity Visit.

The Honourable Justice Belinda Ang Saw Ean

Supreme Court of Singapore

Justice Ang was appointed Judicial Commissioner on 1 February 2002, and was appointed Judge of the Supreme Court of Singapore on 2 January 2003. Justice Ang sits as a specialist judge for Admiralty, Shipping and Arbitration matters including Finance, Securities, Banking, Complex Commercial Cases.

Prior to these appointments, she was a lawyer in private practice and held the title of Senior Counsel (appointed in 1998). Justice Ang was a member of the sub-committee on the Review of Arbitration Laws, appointed by the Attorney-General in 1991, that made recommendations on Singapore's laws relating to international commercial arbitrations, and which led to the enactment of the International Arbitration Act (Cap 143).

Justice Ang is also a member of the Rules Committee, Supreme Court; the Senate and the Executive Board of the Singapore Academy of Law. Justice Ang is the Chairperson of the Singapore Mediation Centre.



The Honourable Justice Quentin Loh

Supreme Court of Singapore

Justice Loh was appointed a Judicial Commissioner of the Supreme Court of Singapore on 1 September 2009 and a Supreme Court Judge on 1 June 2010. Prior to his joining the Bench, he was the Deputy Managing Partner of Rajah & Tann LLP from December 2003 to 12 August 2009. He was a key member of its international arbitration group as well as head of the Construction & Projects and Insurance and Reinsurance practice groups. Prior to joining Rajah & Tann in 2001 as a member of its Executive Committee, he was Managing Partner of Cooma, Lau & Loh, a firm he co-founded in 1978. He was appointed Senior Counsel in 1999. Until his appointment as a Judicial Commissioner, he was also a founding director of Maxwell Chambers, a dedicated building for holding arbitrations.

In private practice, he has appeared as counsel in numerous domestic and international arbitrations, (SIAC and non-SIAC, ad hoc arbitrations, ICC, HKIAC) in various jurisdictions. His areas of practice also included liability insurance, professional negligence claims, D&O claims, regulatory aspects of insurance, reinsurance, building and construction claims, public law, shipping and admiralty, shipbuilding and rig construction claims and a wide range of commercial and corporate litigation.
