

MIDDLE TEMPLE LIBRARY QUICK GUIDE TO CURIA



Curia provides electronic access to information relating to every case brought before the Court of Justice, General Court, and the Civil Service Tribunal from 1953 through the present. This includes information about pending and ongoing cases.

SEARCHING

Information on cases can be found by searching or by browsing. There are two search forms, and several browsing options, including:

- Reports of Cases organised by date
- A numerical list of all cases, divided by Court
- A Digest of case law, available in French
- An alphabetical table of subject matter, available in French

REPORTS OF CASES

The electronic version of the Reports of Cases before the Court of Justice and the General Court (also referred to as the European Court Reports) are authentic and carry legal value as of 1 January 2012 (or 2010 for Reports of Staff Cases). The Reports of Cases are not produced in print after this date.

EUR-Lex and Curia provide access to the electronic Reports of Cases through the general search function. Not every case available through these sites comes from the validated Reports of Cases, however, so view the PDF of the Report to ensure you are viewing a version as published in the Reports of Cases rather than the Official Journal or other version.

On Curia look for a link indicating:

published in the electronic Reports of Cases (Court Reports - general) or for the Report icon. The electronically valid Reports of Cases can also be found by browsing under:

> Court Reports – general

Choose either: Court of Justice or General Court. Select the folder from the appropriate month and year.
